Call to Order

Chair Lawrence called the meeting to order. All three Commissioners were present.

April 1, 2021

Authorization for the Placement of Secure Ballot Collection Boxes for the May 18, 2021 Primary Election – John Marlatt

Chair Lawrence made a motion that the Board approve placing secure permanent ballot collection boxes at the locations listed on the attached document titled “April 19, 2021 Secure Ballot Drop Box Locations” for the upcoming Municipal Primary Election to be held on May 18, 2021 and for all subsequent elections, and that the Chief Clerk of the Board of

Elections, in consultation with the Director of Mail-in Elections, be authorized to designate when collection boxes will be available for use for all elections.

Commissioner Arkoosh seconded the motion.

Vice Chair Gale opposes the processes with the passing of Act 77 and therefore does not approve the placement of ballot collection boxes and satellite locations.

There was no further Board comment. There was no public comment. Chair Lawrence asked for a “roll call” vote with Commissioner Arkoosh and Chair Lawrence voting “aye” and Vice Chair Gale “opposed”. Chair Lawrence brought the motion to a vote and it was adopted.

Authorization for the Relocation of a Satellite Office — John Marlatt

Chair Lawrence made a motion that the Board approve the relocation of the satellite office currently located at 95 South Hanover Street in Pottstown to 101 College Drive in Pottstown.

Commissioner Arkoosh seconded the motion.

There was no further Board comment. There was no public comment. Chair Lawrence asked for a “roll call” vote with Commissioner Arkoosh and Chair Lawrence voting “aye” and Vice Chair Gale “opposed”. Chair Lawrence brought the motion to a vote and it was adopted.

Closing Board Comments

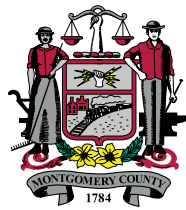

2021 Primary Election Secure Ballot Drop Box Locations

Secure ballot boxes have been placed throughout Montgomery County for constituents to drop-off their ballots prior to the Election on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. Secure boxes will be available for the public to return their completed ballots at the locations listed below 24 hours a day beginning May 1, 2021 at 10:00 AM. Completed ballots must be placed in the drop-off boxes by the time the polls close at 8pm on Election Day, Tuesday, May 18, 2021. Ballots issued by other counties cannot be accepted. All Secure Drop Box Locations are monitored using CCTV Surveillance 24 hours a day.
