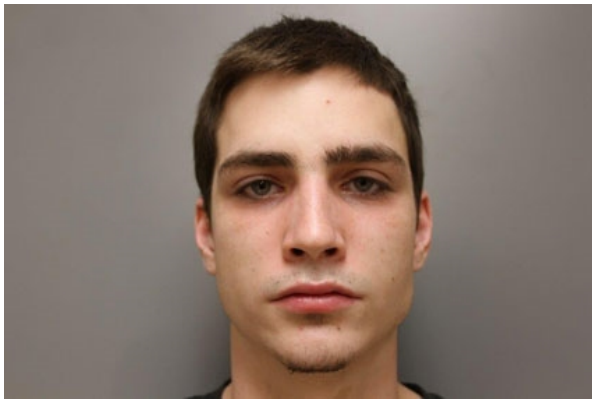

Upper Moreland Stabbing



Montgomery County District Attorney Risa Vetri Ferman and Upper Moreland Township Police Chief Michael Murphy announce the filing of First Degree Murder and related offenses against Jeffrey William Anderson, age 20. The charges were filed following the March 4, 2015, homicide death of William Neill, age 72.

On Wednesday, March 4, 2015 at 2:59 PM, the Upper Moreland Township Police Department responded to a stabbing at 210 Newington Drive in the Hatboro section of Upper Moreland Township. Responding officer's arrested Anderson who was attempting to flee the scene in the victim's Cadillac Escalade. Officers entered the residence and located Neill deceased from apparent stab wounds.

Anderson was arraigned before District Judge Paul Leo and remanded without bail to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility. A preliminary hearing was scheduled for Thursday, March 12, 2015 at 10:00 AM. The case will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Stew Ryan and Kathleen McLaughlin.

An autopsy is scheduled for Friday March 6, 2015, at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office.
