KELSEY MARTIN CHARGED WITH FURNISHING ALCOHOL TO 18-YEAR-OLD CHARGED WITH HBV-DUI AND OTHERS

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (July 13, 2021) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Pottstown Police Chief Mick Markovich announce the filing of a complaint against Kelsey Martin, 35, of Pottstown, on charges of Furnishing Liquor to a Minor for her role in a fatal accident that occurred in North Coventry Township in Chester County on Aug. 10, 2020.

An investigation following the one-car crash that killed 18-year-old Louis Carbajal and led to Homicide by Vehicle-DUI charges against the 18-year-old driver, Connor Quinn, found that those two young men along with two others were drinking at Martin's house prior to the crash and that she provided the alcoholic beverages to them. Further investigation also found that Martin had provided alcohol to some of the young men on a previous occasion. The defendant knew the men through her job as an athletic trainer at the high school where several of them had been athletes.

Martin is charged with six counts of Furnishing Liquor to a Minor (M3). A preliminary hearing has been set for 1 p.m., Aug. 12, 2021 before Magisterial District Judge Edward Kropp Sr.

The case will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Lauren Marvel, captain of the Pottstown Community Justice Unit.
