DA ANNOUNCES JOINT INVESTIGATION INTO AUG. 25th FATAL CRASH IN LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Aug. 29, 2022)—Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Lower Providence Township Police Chief Michael Jackson announce a joint investigation into the Aug. 25, 2022 fatal crash in Lower Providence Township that killed 31-year-old Kellie Adams, of Lansdale, and her baby girl, Emersyn Grace Adams, who was stillborn following the crash.

The crash occurred just before 3 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 25, 2022. Lower Providence Township Police responded to the 500 block of South Park Avenue for a reported two-vehicle crash. Police arrived to find that a head-on crash occurred involving Adams' 2021 Chevrolet Tahoe and a 2003 Ford F650 XLT Super Duty dump body truck. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the dump truck was not injured.

"This is a tragic loss of life of a young mother, pregnant with her third child," said Steele. "Our hearts and prayers go out the family at this very difficult time."

The investigation, which is expected to take several weeks, is being conducted by the Lower Providence Township Police, Montgomery County Detective Bureau and members of the Regional Crash Reconstruction Team.
