

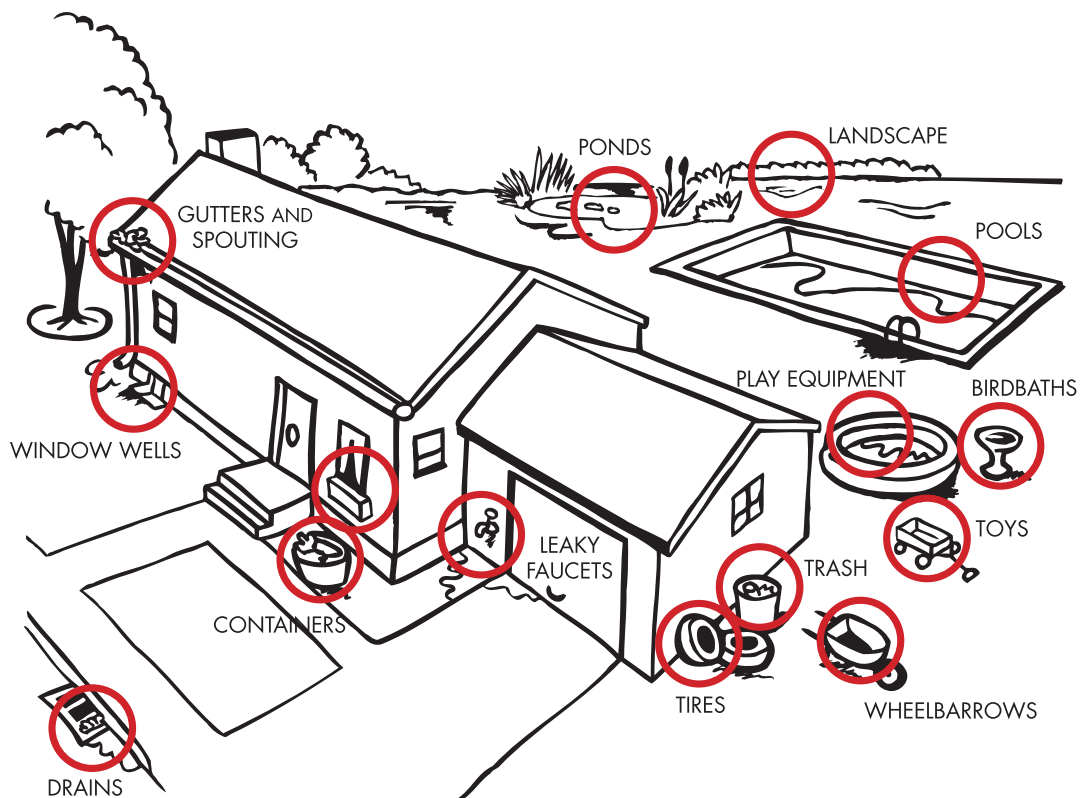
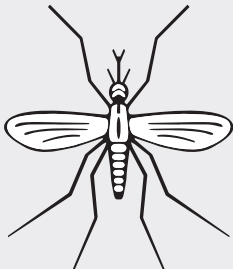


West Nile and Zika Viruses

Start Now!

- Landscape your property to reduce low spots.
- Remove, or turn upside down, anything that holds water.
- Check storm drains, leaky faucets, and window wells.
- Clean and chlorinate all pools as needed.
- Don't allow water to stagnate in birdbaths, pools, or ponds.
- Clean clogged roof gutters and spouting every year.
- Aerate ornamental pools and/or stock with fish.
