- QRS Update
 - QRS agencies will have two choices regarding dispatch to calls
 - Be dispatched to priority 1 calls or they may elect to be dispatched to all EMS calls in their area. In order for the QRS to elect to be dispatched to only priority 1 calls it will require the agreement of the Chief of the EMS agency responsible for primary response in the area.
- Dr. Wang provided an update to the group on a new dispatch policy for QRS response. The QRS will be able to respond either on all dispatches or Priority 1 only.
